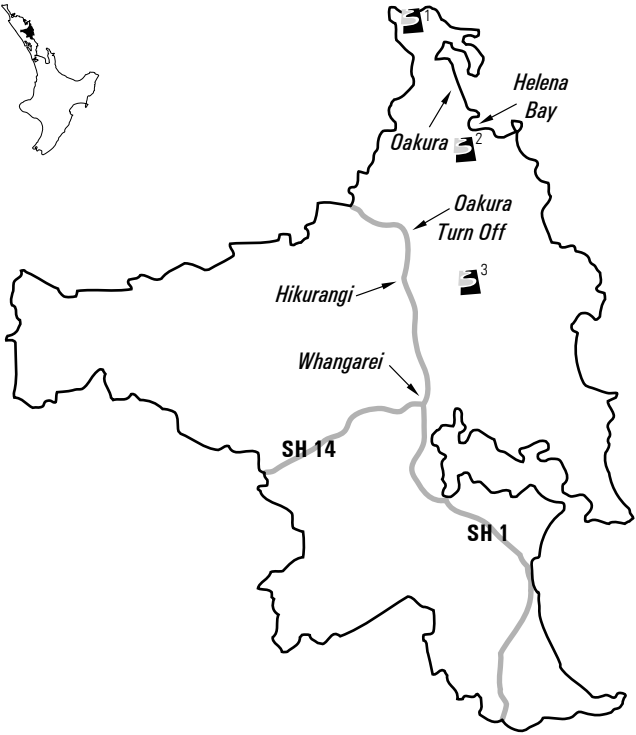

Directions:

106 (1.06 km) McBreen Road. From Hikurangi township take Valley Road east towards the coast (sign-posted to Whananaki South and Matapouri) for 7 km. Turn south onto McBreen Road. We are the second house on the right. Travelling from the Tutukaka Coast, McBreen Road is 20 km from Matapouri.

Every day, all year round

Description:

Grassy paddock next to stream with huge Totorā trees when dry or a gravel hard stand if wet.

Special notes:

Recommend phoning ahead to make sure that we are home for your visit.

Approach: Sealed roads until McBreen, which is gravel (gentle contour). The entry to McBreen Road is easily missed, when coming from Hikurangi look for the turn shortly after the first one-way bridge.

Facilities: Water and one electrical hook-up (\$5/night).
